The Department of Public Safety offers three services to people who require assistance for their vehicles. Those services are performing battery jumps, unlocking vehicles, and providing directions on campus.

If a driver cannot start his/her vehicle due to an uncharged battery, the University Police can assist the driver by responding with appropriate equipment for no fee. However, the driver must be prepared to show a form of identification before assistance is provided. If you should need any of those services, please call the University Police at (973) 720-2300.

If a driver cannot enter his/her vehicle due to the vehicle being locked and due to the key being unavailable, the University Police can assist the driver by unlocking the vehicle for no fee. However, the driver must be prepared to show a form of identification before assistance is provided. If you should need any of those services, please call the University Police at (973) 720-2300.

If a driver needs assistance to find a location on campus, the University Police can provide directions by telephone or in person. A driver needing directions can call (973) 720-2301 for directions, can wave down a university police officer for directions in person, or can stop by the University's Public Safety Building for directions in person and/or for a map of the campus.
