

**Faculty Senate Technology Council  
Minutes - 11/18/2010**

We started the meeting by Welcoming Adjunct representative Doreen Corsetto.

Discussion ensued concerning the need for representatives from the Colleges of Education and Business. Harris will send out feelers.

We used the document contributed by Obroin as a structure for a discussion of the informal poll of our colleagues' technology interests and concerns. Two issues popped to the fore: the need of a physical help desk and greater communication both "up and down," that is, from the faculty to the decision makers and the reverse.

Discussion ensued re: the type and timing of a faculty-wide poll. Security concerns suggest the use of the same system used in Faculty Senate elections. Timing is likely to be late January or early February because a) we don't *have* enough time to get it out in December, and we don't *need* a lot of time between the poll and the forum.

We decided to ask every member of the committee to rank their perception of faculty interests and concerns. Limit the enumeration to five items, and use the email list for discussion prior to our next meeting.
