Saturday, March 7, 2009

The meeting was called to order at approximately 9:05 a.m. in the College Hall Board Room.

In accordance with the "Open Public Meetings Act," the Chairperson publicly announced and had entered into the minutes that "adequate notice" of this meeting was provided. In compliance with the Statute, this notice was posted on the University's web page and distributed to The Herald News, The Record, and The Star Ledger more than 48 hours prior to this meeting.

MINUTES OF THE DECEMBER 5, 2008 AND FEBRUARY 4, 2009 BOARD MEETINGS:
The minutes of the December 5, 2008 and February 4, 2009 Board meetings were approved as distributed.

CHAIRS REPORT:
Mr. Mazzola introduced Ms. Jessica Pepe, the new Student Government Association President and gave an overview of her involvement in University activities and her leadership role in organizing the other New Jersey college SGA leaders in a campaign to lobby NJ legislators and the governor for increased funding for higher education. Ms. Pepe addressed the Board, spoke about her goals as SGA President and thanked the Board for the warm welcome and the support provided by President Speert and the Board.

Mr. Mazzola spoke about a recent Faculty Senate resolution requesting the Board of Trustees to consider adding non-voting faculty representative(s) to the Board. He read the resolution and asked Faculty Senate President, Professor Sue Godar to speak about the resolution. Several Board members asked for further clarification on the Senate's position and rationale for the resolution. They remarked on the Board's history of being both responsive and inclusive regarding faculty input especially in the working sessions at the committee meetings and that their input helps form a major part of the strategies implemented by the Board. It was noted that there is faculty representation on five of the seven Board Committees. Only the Personnel Committee and the Committee on Trustees and Nominations do not have faculty representatives. Professor Godar acknowledged the Board's inclusionary history but indicated
that the Senate shares the opinion that having a representative on the full Board is the next step in the process of promoting full participation, input and collaboration by the faculty.

Professor Sue Tardi offered that there is a preferred dynamic to have a faculty member part of the full Board and that the position is one that is highly regarded. Accordingly, the criteria for a faculty member to be selected to serve on the Board would be crafted with a great deal of deliberation and scrutiny regarding his or her overall knowledge of the University.

Mr. Mazzola thanked Professor Godar and Professor Tardi for their input and indicated the matter would be referred to the Committee on Trustees and Nominations for their discussion and recommendation.

Mr. Mazzola reminded everyone of the $19^{\text {th }}$ Annual Legacy Awards Dinner scheduled for April 25, 2009 and reported that trustee Fred Gruel is an honoree. He encouraged everyone to make an effort to attend the event which supports scholarships for our students, and honors five distinguished alums, and provides a faculty service award to one of our outstanding faculty.

## PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

Dr. Speert introduced Dr. Darryl Greer, Executive Director of the New Jersey Association of Colleges and Universities which is an advocacy organization for the nine state colleges and higher education in New Jersey. Mr. Greer remarked on the wealth of talent New Jersey and William Paterson University in particular has in its students. He applauded the efforts of the Board in collaborating with NJASCU to bring recognition by the State to the value of William Paterson University and higher education in New Jersey.

Dr. Speert gave an update on the FY09 budget and the prospects for the FY10 budget. He reported that we are currently dealing with news from the Governor's office that the state will not be making the second quarter payment of the salary program as previously allocated. The third quarter payment should be coming in the next two weeks but there is grave doubt about whether we will receive the fourth quarter payment. This represents a loss of approximately \$750K - \$800K for William Paterson University. Further Dr. Speert reported that the Governor's Budget message for FY10, which will be delivered on March 10, is expected to be very austere because of the grave budget decisions before the State.

There was some hope that higher education would be able to share in a portion of the Federal Stimulus Package allocated to New Jersey. We, along with the other state colleges, have identified "shovel ready" projects should those monies become available. The appropriations will most likely be made on behalf of K -12 education.

Dr. Speert reported that we are at the point in our Middle States Accreditation process of beginning the Self-Study. Dr. Speert said indications are that this accreditation cycle will have more emphasis on Board involvement in the process extending beyond the initial meeting with the visiting team. Dr. Stephen Hahn, Associate Provost, is chairing the Self-Study Process Steering Committee. He outlined the timeline, the work of the Committee and the participation needed from the University community. He listed the fourteen Middle States Standards of Excellence on which we will be evaluated. He noted that the process is being initiated early enough to allow for maximum inclusion and participation by the University community and to allow sufficient time to develop a Self-Study report that is well-constructed, accurate, comprehensive, and thoughtfully prepared. The Self-Study will be submitted to Middles States in December 2010 or January 2011. The Peer Review by the visiting team from Middle States will be conducted in February or March 2011. The team will submit their report to Middle States
and the Commission will act in June 2011. Updates on the process will be provided to the Board periodically.

## COMMITTEE REPORTS:

FINANCE AND AUDIT COMMITTEE:
Mr. Taylor reported on the meeting of the Finance and Audit Committee of February 13, 2009 and the presentation made by Ms. Shelly Masi, partner with KPMG on the 2008 Federal A-133 and NJ 04-04 Audits performed at William Paterson University. Ms. Masi reported to the Board on the conduct of that single audit for FY08 and the resulting clean opinion rendered by KPMG. She noted that last year's audit also resulted in no findings and a clean opinion.

Mr. Taylor presented the following resolution for approval, as recommended by the Finance and Audit Committee:

The resolution was unanimously adopted.
Mr. Taylor reported that the balance of income and expenses for the current fiscal year was reviewed and projections indicated we would end FY09 with a balanced budget. The finance dashboard indicators were also reviewed - the educational and general expenses per FTE, and our relative position of midpoint among our sister institutions and efforts to maintain that position. The other indicator - debt per FTE has been targeted at $\$ 25,000$, and the Finance and Audit Committee will discuss establishing a range rather than a single point going forward. Considering the debt for the Science Building project, a range may be a more accurate indicator. Mr. Taylor reported that Ms. Kate Muldoon, Executive Director of our Small Business Development Center reported that we received recognition for being one of the top ten institutions in the state contracting with small, women-owned, and minority-owned businesses.

## INSTITUTIONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE:

Mr. Mazzola reported that the Committee met on February 13. He remarked that the economy has been very central to all of the Committee and Board discussions. It is a very positive reflection that the students at William Paterson University are engaged and active in promoting appropriate funding for higher education to the legislature and the Governor. As state funding decreases, the University has had to seek other sources of funding to support its programs and students. Ms. Meredith McCarthy presented the two main goals of the Annual Fund - to increase giving and to increase alumni engagement. The level of alumni engagement is key to securing commitments from corporations for grants and awards. VP Deller acknowledged the leadership of Ms. Nancy Norville and Ms. McCarthy and because of their efforts we are 3\% ahead of our last year's gifts year to date. Ms. Deller also reported that we are at $67 \%$ of a very ambitious goal of $\$ 485,000$. She said that in order to reach the dashboard goal for alumni giving they must reach 4,833 donors. Currently we have $3,000+$. The staff is working diligently to reach the goal.

## EDUCATION POLICY COMMITTEE:

Mr. Pesce complimented the SGA President and leaders for their initiative in bringing attention to the need for more budgetary support for higher education and William Paterson University in particular. He also mentioned that if mobilizing the Board to speak out on this issue would be beneficial, he would welcome the opportunity to do so. Mr. Pesce reported that the Education Policy Committee met on February 13. He noted that Provost Weil provided an update on grants received by the faculty for the period November 2008 - February 2009 in the amount of about $\$ 300 \mathrm{~K}$ and total grant awards for FY09 at $\$ 6.5 \mathrm{M}$. The Committee received a presentation by Associate Provost Stephen Hahn on the Middle States Accreditation process. Mr. Pesce noted the symmetry between the Middle States Standards of Excellence and the dashboard indicators developed by the Board. The results of the 2008 Faculty Survey on Student Engagement and the 2008 National Survey on Student Engagement will be reviewed once they are aggregated. Ms. Carmen Ortiz, Director of EOF gave a presentation on the EOF program and its accomplishments in the area of retention and graduation.

## STUDENT AFFAIRS COMMITTEE:

Dr. Pruitt reported that the Committee met on February 13 and was notified that Dr. Glen Sherman was selected by Outside the Classroom as the recipient of the 2008-2009 Outstanding Alcohol \& Drug Prevention Professional Award. Campus safety was discussed with an update on recent events. Enrollment management was also discussed and spring '09 enrollment shows an increase over last spring. Fall '09 enrollment projections are on target at this time. Students participated in a satisfaction survey and there will be some follow-up discussion on the results.

OTHER BUSINESS:
At approximately 12:00 p.m. there being no further business, a motion was made and seconded for the meeting to be adjourned. The motion carried unanimously.
